Things To Bring:

- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant)
- Towel
- Swim suit/swim-clothes (Girls: 1-piece/conservative or shorts/sports bra & t-shirt, please)
- Water socks/shoes (if available)
- Shoes with closed toes (e.g. boots, sneakers. Sliders and sandals won't cut it when we are playing games, riding horses, and hiking! Don't wear your best shoes...they WILL get dirty.)
- Sleeping bag and pillow (if you can...we'll provide bedding if you don't have any to bring!)
- Any required personal medications

If there is anything you are missing from this list, let us know -- we want to make sure you have everything you need.

Things **NOT** To Bring:

- Snacks or drinks (We'll feed you well!)
- Knives or other weapons
- Any illegal substances
- Money or valuables

Important Note: Phones or other electronic devices are best left at home so they don't get lost/damaged. If you do bring these things, we'll turn them off and collect them when we leave Las Vegas and keep them safe for you until you are on the way back home.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS:
